TITLE: A Resolution for Solidarity with the Students affected by Super Typhoon Yutu

### I. Purpose

This resolution is to call for ASBSU and the greater University to be in solidarity with the students affected by Super Typhoon Yutu that hit the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, a U.S. territory, on Oct. 25, 2018 (ChST).

### II. Rationale

WHEREAS, ASBSU believes in advocating for the interests of all students at the University.

WHEREAS, ASBSU supports marginalized and underrepresented students at the University.

WHEREAS, ASBSU recognizes the importance for a community to come together during a natural disaster in order to offer support for affected students as well as to address possible secondary trauma.

WHEREAS, knowledge of the U.S. territories, including the CNMI, is very limited on campus.

WHEREAS, this Resolution will increase awareness of the situation since there was little to no national coverage regarding the typhoon.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Associated Students of Boise State University that we pledge to support our fellow students from the CNMI affected by Super Typhoon Yutu through various forms of outreach and campaigns. We will also advocate for their continued support within administration.

### III. Provisions

This will be delivered to the Dean of Students to acknowledge ASBSU as a resource for the affected students. This resolution would enable ASBSU support to students in various relief efforts. Examples include, but are not limited to, fundraisers, campaigns, or promotional quad days.

This resolution will be posted on the Associated Students of Boise State University website as its official statement regarding Super Typhoon Yutu.

There will be no immediate fiscal impact.


